Cape Air launches two new routes in New England

Boston's Logan International Airport – Lebanon, New Hampshire, Rockland, Maine

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For Immediate Release-Hyannis, MA- November 12, 2008- Cape Air made it official today with the ribbon cut on two new routes serving Boston's Logan International Airport. "With great pride we can say with our non-stop service to nine cities from Boston's Logan International Airport we really are New England's regional airline," says Cape Air's founder and CEO Dan Wolf. "From Maine to the Adirondacks to our home base on Cape Cod and the Islands, Cape Air now gives thousands of local residents and visitors access to and from the national air transportation network," Wolf added.

"We're excited about the low cost connections Cape Air will deliver to our market," says David Gobin, Lebanon Airport Manager. "With six round trip flights to Boston each day, they will connect us to where our market wants to go – to over 60 shuttle flights from

Boston/Logan to the New York City area, 37 daily flights to the Washington DC area, and over 40 daily international flights – all in less than 60 minutes travel time from the Upper Valley.” We’re thrilled to have Cape Air service to Logan,” said Bob Hastings, Executive Director of the Penobscot Bay Regional Chamber of Commerce. “The low fares and daily service to New England’s most important hub is going to be a hit with the business community here.”
