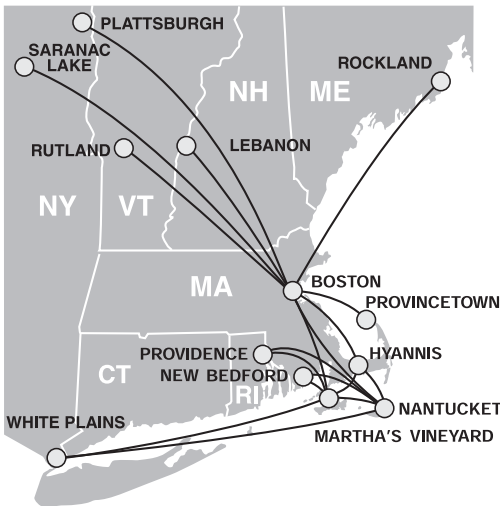




Cape Air Announces New Non-Stop Air Service White Plains – Nantucket & Martha's Vineyard
